Dreams to Reality

Importing miniature horses from the USA

Have you ever looked at a website, seen your dream horse, only to realise that it is the USA. How do you go about getting it back to the UK? Well here a few guidelines about the process.

Miniature horses being shipped into the UK must undergo a minimum 30 day quarantine period at an United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) approved facility. A few miniature horse farms are already approved and if you have purchased from one of these farms you may find it cheaper to quarantine at their facility. However before you do so find out which airport your horses will be flying out of. As if they are in different States, upon leaving the quarantine facility the horse trailer in which they are travelling has to be sealed by a USDA vet and unsealed by USDA vet upon arrival at the airport. This is fine if the two places are a reasonable distance apart but remember that America is a huge country and your horses cannot be tended to on the journey as this will void the quarantine period that they have already been through. So shipping your horse(s) to a facility nearer to the airport may be a better idea.

Check out your chosen quarantine facility, find out whether your horse(s) will be stabled all the time, what facilities there will be for exercise and feeding. Make sure that if your horses are clipped that you have rugs, hoods etc available for them as the quarantine facility will not provide them.

Whilst they are in quarantine a USDA vet will visit to take blood samples and/or vaccinate against various diseases such as Equine Viral Arteritis and Contagious Equine Metritis.

The vet will complete a Health Certificate which is required to import a horse into the UK.

On the day of shipping the horse(s) have to undergo a five hour quarantine at an approved station which will be close to the airport. The horses are then accompanied by a USDA vet to the airport.

The state of departure may also make a charge e.g. Texas Departure of Agriculture will charge \$40.00 dollars per horse.

Miniature horses are either shipped in wooden crates that are made for the size of your horse or in a full size horse container. The full size horse containers can be divided into three so that a mixture of mares, stallions and young stock can be carried. A full size container can carry up to eight minis depending on their size. The wooden crates can be made to carry between one and four miniature horses.

Dreams to Reality cont....

Live Horses can only be imported into the UK through one of the following airports,

London Heathrow, London Luton, London Stansted, Prestwick.

Importers must provide one working day's advance notice in writing (fax or email are acceptable) to the Divisional Veterinary Manager responsible for the Border Inspection post, of their intention to import. They must specify the quantity, nature of the consignment and estimated time of the animals arrival.

Importers must notify the Divisional Veterinary Manager responsible for the Border Inspection Post if for any reason, the arrival of a consignment is cancelled, postponed or delayed.

You must appoint a handling/shipping agent who is authorised to handle your horse(s) and process it through the Border Inspection post and Customs and Excise, as until it has passed through these points you are not allowed any contact with the animals. Charges for this service are not set and you should get quotes for this service before appointing an agent.

On arrival the horse(s) is conveyed directly to the Border Inspection Post where they will be subject to documentary, identity checks and physical examinations. DEFRA charges the following fees for these checks, (Charges correct at time of going to press)

Basic fee per animal

£7.00

Fee per additional animal in the consignment after first 50 animals

£5.00

Minimum fee

£25.00

Additional charges for out-of-hours working

Checks and controls started between 00.00 to 08.30 and 17.00 to 24.00 Monday to Friday

1.5 x normal fee

Checks and controls started 00.00 Saturday to 24.00 Sunday and 00.00 to 24.00 public holidays Double the standard fee plus £50.

All miniature horses that are imported into the UK are liable for payment of Duty and VAT on the purchase cost of the horse and the shipping costs. The Handling/Shipping Agent will complete a Form C88 Standard Import duty and will invoice you for these charges.

Every item has commodity code, these can be found by phoning the Tariff Classification Help line. Telephone number 01702 366077. The Commodity code for breeding horses is 0101101000.

At the time of going to press this means that you are liable for 0% duty, 17.5% VAT, there are no restrictions, no licence is required. HM Customs and Excise can give you up-to-date information on 0845 0109000.

Having cleared Customs and Border Inspection you horse(s) will be released for you or your appointed agent to transport to their final destination.

The above prices and information are given as guidelines only and were correct at time of going to press. The final cost that you pay will be dependent upon factors such as the weight/size f the horse, value original, location, exchange rate, delays etc. The MHCGB will not be held liable for any changes in this information.

Are you interested in importing horses from the USA? If you are contact me at mhcgb@btconnect.com as we are going to try and compile a register so that horses can be imported in larger groups to reduce costs.
