#### **OUR FIRST TRAINING CLINIC**

What a great way to begin a new year . On the 15<sup>TH</sup> January 2005 we attended a training clinic held at New Close Farm in Stockton. This clinic was taken by Joanne Ross of Scott Creek Farm Miniatures . Joanne has bred and worked with these little horses for many years and is a leading authority on them. She has written many interesting and informative articles on miniatures which show what a great insight she has with this breed. So it was really exciting to attend a training clinic being taken by her.

The clinic was well attended and many people brought their own horses to work with, however Jill Robinson was kind enough to loan out horses to those didn't have their own horses to work with. It Turned out to be not only a really fun day but a very informative day too and I am sure that everyone went home wiser and with ideas on how to improve their handling skills

Joanne began the mornings lesson by taking a young colt who had not been worked with and showed us how to work with him in a round pen to get him to bond to her. It didn't take long for this little colt to be doing just what she wanted him to do.

She then proceeded to take him from the pen and halter him and then began showing us how to work with a youngster when training them for halter class. We were not the only newcomers to miniatures that were attending this class and it was so interesting to see this done.

The next part of the training session was about how to get our horses to stand correctly when shown, she also got each person to show their horse as though at a show and she made comment on how each horse and handler went and added tips and much encouragement on how they could improve.

We then broke for lunch. Lunch was provided by Jill, Janice and Janice's. A super spread it was too.

The afternoon session kicked off with Joanne showing us how you can help improve the way some horses walk by careful study and techniques on how to rasp the hooves to put right minor faults. Again this showed Joanne's great skill with these horses and I am sure even those that have worked with miniatures for a long time would have taken home some very interesting things to put into practice.

The next part of the day was taken up with showing us how to train for utility and how to help your horses jump well. This was fun for everyone both those doing and those just watching. You could see how well the horses improved even in a very short time frame.

The final part of the day was taken up with teaching us how to get a horse ready to drive. Joanne took a horse that had not been driven and got him to wear the harness and showed us how to work first on the ground with him getting him used to the reins, it was amazing how quickly this horse began to see exactly what she was expecting of him and it didn't take very long till she was able to introduce the cart.

Jill Robinson then very kindly brought in her top USA driving horses, Del Terras Dellas Joe Berry, Royal Oaks Mystical silver Moon and her new addition FLF stars lunar Eclipse another USA national top 10 driving and halter horse and she very kindly allowed anyone who want to have a go at driving to have a go with these gorgeous horses.

What a great day. Everyone had fun and I am sure everyone went home much wiser. All I can add to this report and I am sure that everyone else who attended would agree

# The Story of Little Miracle

After losing my Beautiful Skewbald Mare at the age of 34 I decided to buy a miniature horse from a friend of mine knowing she was about to foal and I called her "ALI" (Allegro Indian Princess).

When she arrived at Allegro and had settled herself in the vet came out to examine her and said as we had no covering date it was hard to say when she would foal but in her opinion it would not be too long, so I checked my little girl every hour day and night and this went on week after week after week. After about 3 weeks the vet came again to check Ali over and told me the foal was about due but she was not happy as she had felt no movement from it. A couple of weeks went by and still no foal. The vet had to come out again to keep a check on Ali and on that visit told me she was 96% sure the foal was dead but that the mare had to give birth naturally so to keep an eye on her.

On Wednesday 23rd July 2003 at 11am I noticed Ali behaving very strange and when I looked I saw what looked like black blood down her back legs and immediately got the vet to her who said it was the start of a haemorrhage and as I had no other transport Ali and I were promptly loaded into a Transit Van and taken to the vets.



Within half an hour and pacing up and down like an expectant father hoping I was not going to loose Ali as well, the vet came out and told me that Ali would be

not going to loose Ali as well, the vet came out and told me that Ali would be OK and had a tiny little filly foal who was fighting to live but was very weak and they did not hold out much hope. Four times my little foal stopped breathing and four times the vets revived her and then from laying motionless the little foal struggled to her feet measuring in at just 12 inches and wobbling everywhere, her little eyes opening wide as she said "Hello" to the world. When the vet asked what I would call her the only name that came to

mind was "Miracle" because that is exactly what my beautiful foal was in my eyes.

After four days I brought mum and babe home but still my foal lay motionless only getting up to suckle and even then sometimes I had to wake her, even to go out to play she had to be woken and carried around until she realised she could run.

Miracle stayed with her mum for eight months and when it was time to take her away she went to live with Jack (a miniature colt I bought from Patti) in his stable and they became the best of friends and still are.



In 2004 Miracle went to Melsonby Show and was placed 4th, twice. I was really pleased and then she went to Warren Farm Show at Wolveston where she took 2nd and made everybody laugh by lying down and resting between classes like a well trained Labrador.

Towards the end of 2004 my little foal was in trouble again, this time uncoordinated and not being able to focus properly. The vet took blood tests and told me if it proved to be

her liver or her nervous system we would loose her. For the next four days we worried and watched as little Miracle got steadily worse and then the phone rang with the news we had been waiting for. Nothing wrong with her liver or her nervous system but she has more white blood cells than red and too much protein being made so we have to give Miracle syrup prescribed by the vet every day, but she is in good health now and so my little girl wins yet another battle to live and comes up trumps.

Miracle will never be a strong horse and will always have little problems but she is the little horse with a big heart and a will to live and is loved by everyone who meets her and I am sure she will appear at a couple of local shows in 2005 just to prove to everyone that...


