An “In” & “Out” is two jumps (if they refuse the second fence they cannot jump the first one again)

Novice - First round no bigger than 18inch

Open - First round 18-28inches

Increase of 1-6inch per round

After reaching maximum height (44 inch) keep jumping until tie is broken

A course is considered set once a horse has started the course

Elimination:

3 Refusals. Off course. Baiting. Chain over nose or in mouth. Failure to pass between start and finish cones. Loss of control. Carrying a whip.
