AMHA Halter Obstacle Class 2020

Competing animals must not be less than two (2) years of age

Please refer to AMHA current rule book for rules regarding Halter Obstacle Classes

To be scored as per AMHA Halter Obstacle Score Sheet

Trotting poles

Entre through the start cones at a trot and cover the trotting poles at an even gate. Halt once through the obstacle. Poles will be set a minimum of 16" up to a maximum of 24" apart.

Side pass

Align with the final pole and side pass in the direction stated.

Jump

Jump will be straight bar set no higher than 12inch with ground pole

Ground Tie

Walk horse into marked area, place lead onto floor to create a ground tie. Proceeded to walk around the horse a full 180 degrees the collect the lead. Exit the marked area at a calm walk

Figure of 8

At a trot, bend around the cones to create a figure of 8 shape.

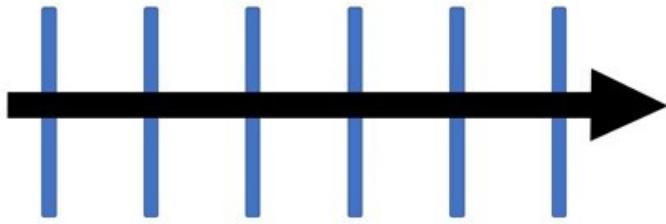
Rein Back

Trot forward into the marked space, halt then rein back out of the space.

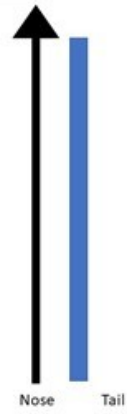
Tarpaulin

Trot calmly across the tarpaulin., and continue to trot to exit the ring through the finish cones

Ground Tie

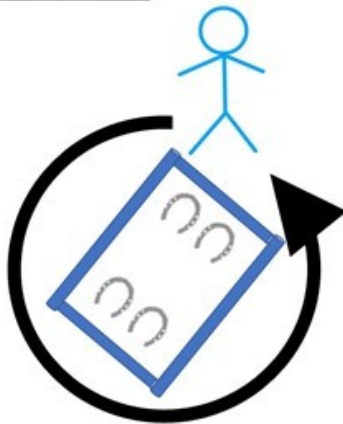
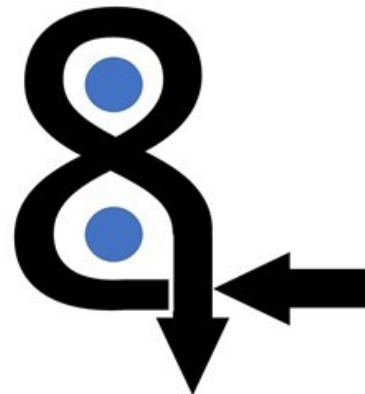
