EQUIMANIA SHOWING RULES

GENERAL RULES:

- ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.
- EQUIMANIA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES WITHOUT EXPLANATION.
- COMPETITOR NUMBERS MUST BE WORN/CLEARLY DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES WHILST MOUNTED. THIS INCLUDES WORKING IN ANY WHERE ON THE SHOWSITE.
- IN CLASSES WHERE QUALIFIERS WILL BE HELD THE SOCIETY RULES OVERRIDE EQUIMANIA AND WHERE MORE THAN ONE SOCIETY ARE INVOLVED IT IS THE DESCRETION OF THE SHOW SECRETARY ON THE DAY TO ADVISE WHICH SOCIETY HAS PRECEDENCE.
- ALL EQUINES MUST BE LED, RIDDEN AND UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COMPETENT PERSON AT ALL TIMES. HANDLERS OF LEAD REIN PONIES MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE, AND MUST WALK AT ALL TIMES.
- CONTAGIOUS DISEASE - ALL EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED TO BE AWARE OF ANIMALS ON THE SHOWGROUND AND ENSURE THAT ALL EXHIBITS ARE FIT AND WELL. IF AT ANY TIME YOU ARE CONCERNED PLEASE REPORT TO THE OFFICE.
- EXHIBITORS ARE REMINDED THAT IT IS A LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO CARRY PASSPORTS FOR ALL HORSES/PONIES WHEN COMPETING AND TRAVELLING.
- BEHAVIOUR OF AN OFFENSIVE, ABUSIVE OR UNPLEASANT MANNER TO ANY PERSON OR ANIMAL WILL NOT BE TOLERATED, ANYONE FOUND BEHAVING IN SUCH A WAY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE WITHOUT ANY REFUND OF ENTRY FEES
- EQUIMANIA DOES NOT ACCEPT ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE OF PROPERTY HOWSOEVER CAUSED.
- DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING AREA OR SHOWING RINGS. THEY ARE ALLOWED ON LEADS ELSEWHERE AND OWNERS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEM
- HORSE OR PONIES MUST NOT BE LEFT IN HORSEBOXES OVERNIGHT.

SHOW CLASS RULES

- CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP UNLESS IT IS UNAVOIDABLE. COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THEY ARE AT THE COLLECTING RING IN PLENTY OF TIME TO COMPETE
- THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.

- STEWARDS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL HEALTH AND SAFETY MATTERS WITHIN THE SHOWING RING SO COMPETITORS MUST FOLLOW ALL REQUESTS MADE BY THE RING STEWARD
- NO ANIMAL OR RIDER MAY LEAVE THE RING WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE JUDGE AND/OR RING STEWARD.
- NO EXHIBIT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE CLASS IN HAND OR RIDDEN ONCE THE INITIAL TROT UP HAS COMMENCED
- IN BOTH IN HAND AND RIDDEN CLASSES ANY FALL OF HANDLER, HORSE OR RIDER WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND THEY MUST LEAVE THE RING DISMOUNTED ONCE THEY ARE ABLE TO.
- FOLLOWING ANY FALL OF HANDLER HORSE OR RIDER IN ANY CLASS CONSIDERATION MUST BE MADE AS TO WHETHER OR NOT TO CONTINUE SHOWING FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY. EQUIMANIA RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMISSION TO SUBSEQUENT CLASSES IF THEY FEEL THE INDIVIDUAL OR HORSE DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE SAFE TO DO SO.
- PARENTS OF CHILDREN INVOLVED IN FALLS MUST MAKE THE SHOW SECRETARY AWARE IF THEY WISH THEIR CHILD TO CONTINUE SHOWING. EQUIMANIA RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMISSION TO SUBSEQUENT CLASSES IF THEY FEEL THE CHILD DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE SAFE TO DO SO
- ONCE THE CLASS HAS COMMENCED THERE SHALL BE NO CHANGE OF RIDER, EXCEPT IN A CHAMPIONSHIP WHEN A RIDER FINDS THAT THEY HAVE MORE THAN ONE EXHIBIT TO COMPETE. THE SUBSTITUTE RIDER MUST BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE CLASS AND THE RING STEWARD INFORMED OF THE CHANGE OF RIDER.
- ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR HATS THAT ARE CORRECTLY SECURED BRITISH STANDARD SKULL CAPS/RIDING HATS THAT MEET CURRENT SAFETY STANDARDS. Hats bearing only the EN1384 or BSEN1384 standard **will no longer be accepted under BHS hat rules.** However, hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and **another standard** such as those listed:
 - PAS 015 (1998 or 2011)
 - VG1 01.040 (2014-12)
 - ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards)
 - SNELL E2001
 - AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards)

Any competitor who ignores this rule will be competing entirely at their own risk and no liability whatsoever can be directed at Equimania in any circumstance.

If the competitor is under 18, then parents are deemed to have accepted this on their behalf. If any competitor is found to be wearing any unacceptable hat then they will be disqualified from any placings and will not be permitted to compete without a suitable replacement hat.
- IN THE EVENING PERFORMANCES (AND ANY ASSOCIATED PRE-JUDGING) TOP HATS OR BOWLERS MAY BE WORN BY RIDERS 18 YEARS AND OVER PROVIDED A SIGNED DISCLAIMER IS WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY BEFORE THE RELATIVE CLASS AND THAT THEY UNDERSTAND THEY DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- COMPETITORS AGED 16 YEARS AND UNDER MUST WEAR A SECURED

CURRENT BSI STANDARD SKULL/RIDING HAT WHETHER COMPETING IN RIDDEN OR IN HAND CLASSES.

- IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY, NO EAR RINGS, PIERCINGS OR VISIBLE JEWELLERY SHOULD BE WORN WHILST COMPETING.
- BODY PROTECTORS – MAY BE WORN AND ARE RECOMMENDED FOR UNDER 16 YEAR OLDS
- SHOW CANES – ARE NOT TO EXCEED 75CMS (30"). HUNTING CROPS ARE PERMISSIBLE IN HUNTER AND SHOW HORSE CLASSES ONLY
- STALLIONS – IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY, STALLIONS MAY ONLY BE RIDDEN/HANDLED BY PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS, **WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SMALL BREEDS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OR MINIATURE HORSE** STALLIONS, WHERE THE RIDER/HANDLER MUST HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 12TH BIRTHDAY BY THE 1ST JANUARY IN THE CURRENT YEAR.
- STALLIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN ANY YOUNG HANDLER, JUNIOR RIDDEN M&M, LEAD REIN OR FIRST RIDDEN CLASSES.

COMPLAINTS

IN THE UNLIKELY EVENT THAT A COMPETITOR HAS REASON TO MAKE A COMPLAINT OR LODGE AN OBJECTION THEN THEY MUST IN PERSON (AND AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN WRITING) MAKE IT TO THE SHOW SECRETARY WITH A DEPOSIT OF £25 WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE COMPLAINT IS UPHOLD.

ALL COMPLAINTS CAN ONLY BE MADE BY A COMPETITOR AT THE SHOW REGARDING A MATTER THAT HAS DIRECTLY IMPACTED ON THEM. HOWEVER, IF THEY WITNESS A MATTER OF SIGNIFICANT SERIOUSNESS THEN THEY MAY SPEAK TO THE SHOW SECRETARY IN CONFIDENCE WHO WILL CONSIDER THE INCIDENT AND ACT ACCORDINGLY.

IF ANY OFFICIAL, JUDGE, COMPETITOR OR SPECTATOR AT THE SHOW HAS ANY CONCERNS REGARDING THE WELFARE OF ANY PERSON OR EQUINE THEY MUST MAKE THEIR CONCERNS KNOWN TO THE SHOW SECRETARY SO ANY ACTION NEEDED IS TAKEN,

RING STEWARDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN INCIDENT FORM FOR ANY UNUSUAL OCCURRENCE

THIS WILL INCLUDE:

- FALL OF HORSE RIDER OR HANDLER;
- ABUSIVE OR UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT TOWARDS OTHER COMPETITORS, OFFICIALS OR JUDGES,
- UNRULY SPECTATORS
- ANY WELFARE CONCERN – EQUINE (OVERUSE OF WHIP ETC) OR HUMAN (ABUSE TO A CHILD)

Pure Bred classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

Stallions – All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle.

Stallions and colts over the age of two, **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.
