An "In" & "Out" is two jumps (if they refuse the second fence they cannot jump the first one again)

Novice - First round no bigger than 18inch

Open - First round 18-28inches

Increase of 1-6inch per round

After reaching maximum height (44 inch) keep jumping until tie is broken

A course is considered set once a horse has started the course

Circling or path crossing will incur a 3-point penalty per occurrence

Knock downs will incur a 4-point penalty per fault.

1st Refusal will incur 5-points, 2nd Refusal 10-points and a 3rd Refusal results in Elimination

**Elimination:**

3 Refusals. Off course. Baiting. Chain over nose or in mouth. Failure to pass between start and finish cones. Loss of control. Carrying a whip.



Each obstacle can be awarded up to 10 points, to be judged on:  
 1) Calmness of Horse  
 2) Completion of Obstacle

Additional mark out of 20 for competence of handler throughout the course.  
 Maximum time per obstacle is 60seconds  
 Course is NOT against the clock

Horses to be worked in American performance halter / head collar with NO BIT  
 Show halters are not permitted

Lead should be between 8 & 12ft long  
 No wips allowed

All exhibitors should wear gloves and suitable footwear.

Junior exhibitors (16years and under) are to wear an approved British Standard hardhat.

Disqualification:

Taking an obstacle in the wrong direction. Negotiating an obstacle from the wrong side. Off pattern. Baiting. Skipping an obstacle unless directed by the judge. Negotiating obstacles in the wrong sequence. Horse working outside the course boundary. Failure to follow the correct line of travel between obstacles.
