- Open - First round 18-28inches
- Increase of 1-6inch per round
- After reaching maximum height (44 inch) keep jumping until tie is broken
- A course is considered set once a horse has started the course
- Circling or path crossing will incur a 3-point penalty per occurrence
- Knock downs will incur a 4-point penalty per fault.
- 1st Refusal will incur 5-points, 2nd Refusal 10-points and a 3rd Refusal results in Elimination

Elimination:
3 Refusals. Off course. Baiting. Chain over nose or in mouth. Failure to pass between start and finish cones. Loss of control. Carrying a whip.
