



MHCGB Test for the National Premier Miniature Horse Show 2020 Novice Test

Competitors are allowed a caller for this test

In-hand competitors should work from the horse's shoulder holding a single lead.

Horses should be worked in a bridle (bit-less are permitted).

Long Reined competitors must be in a roller and long reins.

Cruppers are allowed; Overchecks / Sidechecks are not.

To be long reined in a 15x30m arena

Movement 1	A X C	Enter in Medium Walk, proceed down the centre line Halt, Immobility, Salute. Proceed in Medium Walk Track Right
Movement 2	C M B F A	Transition to Working Trot Circle Right, full width of arena (15m) Transition to Medium Walk
Movement 3	A	Halt, Immobility 4 Seconds, proceed in Medium Walk
Movement 4	K X M M C	Change Rein in Free Walk Transition to Medium Walk
Movement 5	C H E K A	Transition to Working Trot Circle Left, full width of arena (15m) Transition to Medium Walk
Movement 6	A	Serpentine of 3 Loops
Movement 7	H X F F A	Change Rein in Free Walk Transition to Medium Walk
Movement 8	E X B	Track Right Halt, rein back 2 steps, proceed in Medium Walk Track Left
Movement 9	M C H E K K A	Transition to Working Trot Shallow Loop to $\frac{3}{4}$ line Transition to Medium Walk
Movement 10	A G	Down the Centre Line Halt, Immobility, Salute

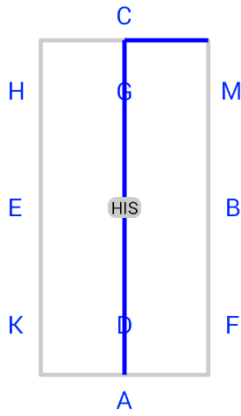
All exhibitors should wear gloves and suitable footwear.

Junior exhibitors (16years and under) are to wear an approved British Standard hardhat.

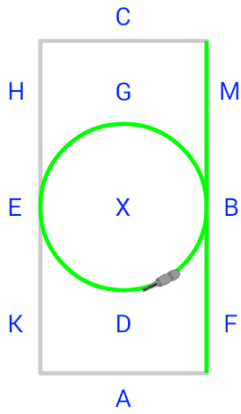
Handlers may carry a dressage whip.

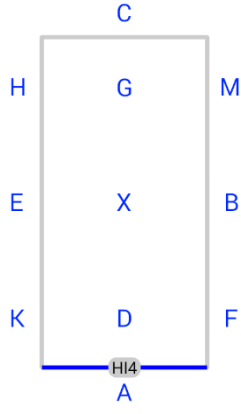

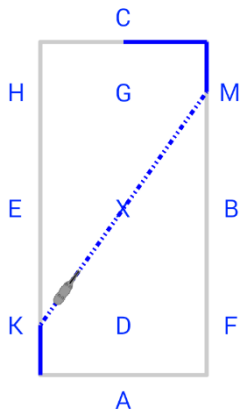

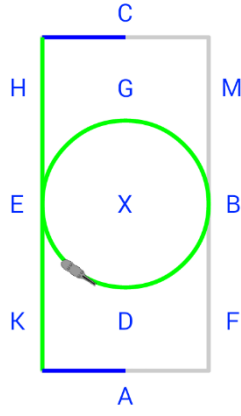

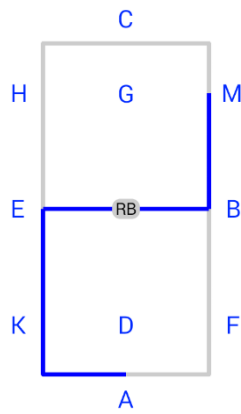

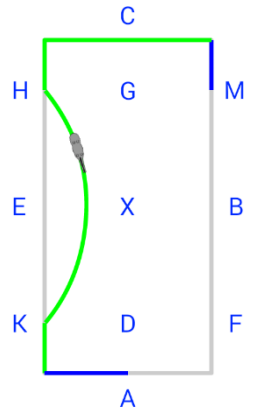

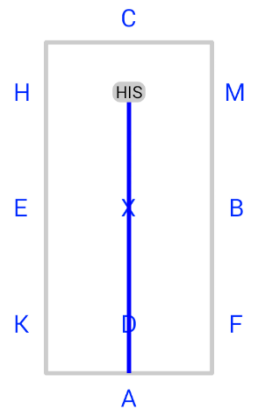
