- The use of voice or the clicking of the tongue by the handler as an aid is permitted and encouraged.
- Miniature Horses can be unclipped but lightly trimmed up, partly clipped, or fully clipped. Shetland ponies can compete unclipped and untrimmed.
- Bridle or smart headcollar (with/without bit) long reins and roller required for long rein test.
- * Bridle or smart headcollar (with/without bit) and lead rein required for in-hand test.
- If you wish to compete driven please increase the arena size to 20m x 40m and increase 10m circles to 20m
